Letter drafted with concerns on proposed Assessing Reforms Proposal of State Treasurer, presented to Board for review. Most paperwork entered on computer. Month of April was spent filing and making room in file cabinets for upcoming filing (5 banker boxes with overflow documents). Continuing collection of data from Equalization, Building Inspection, and Branch County Abstract and Title offices.

Zoning Report-Jim Webb: 1 deck permit issued, and on-going review of land split process.

Litchfield Fire Dept. Report-Chris Brenner: 84% of budget used. Jaws of Life equipment is ready to use.

Road Commission Report-Gary Smith: Robinson Road gravel project to begin the 2nd week of June. Sealcoat of Butler Road to be done in July.
